One of the distinctive design elements of this chair series is the pierced back panel in four styles: Spider, Key, Xweave, and Horizontal Slot.

Furthermore, although traditionally inspired, this chair includes contemporary styling touches with its wide back rail, gently curved legs, and the accentuated reveal lines at the joint of the arm to front and back posts.
